Tournament and BBQ: A Great Success

On Thursday morning, April 28, as the tents for the evening's BBQ were being blown about, weather forecasters were calling for possible tornadoes. Dark clouds loomed. But, as mid-afternoon approached, the clouds parted, and a Carolina blue sky prevailed for the entire Third Annual Butch & Tammy Davis Tailgate Golf Tournament and BBQ. Therein lies a tale: Thanks to generous contributions from local businesses, corporations, and individual members of our community, this special event grossed \$144,550 that directly benefits the families we serve.

The two-day combined event—a BBQ and Auction Thursday evening, followed by a Friday golf tournament at UNC's Finley Golf Course—involved nearly 400 guests, including sponsors, donors, golfers, volunteers, House guests and patients, and helped to spread the word about the work being done at Family



House. Woody Durham, the voice of the Tar Heels, served as emcee for the evening's festivities. The highlight of the program was Woody's interview with several members of the 2011–12 football team.

Butch and Tammy Davis served as the event's main sponsors and hosts. In three years they have helped raise in excess of \$400,000 for Family House. The other primary sponsors this year were UNC Health Care, RBC Bank and Skanska.

Golfers paid just over \$20,000 in registration fees; patrons of the BBQ paid



another \$9,000 to eat ribs and all the fixings donated by the Chapel Hill Restaurant Group; and the silent and live auctions together brought in \$25,955 for the House. A limited edition Louis Moinet Chronograph timepiece that Coach Davis wore throughout the 2010–2011 football season was the big ticket item in the live auction, bringing in \$5,000.

The winning foursome for the golf tournament was Mike Riggsbee, Bill Tate, Ryan Baucom and Bill Hooks.

Thomas Franks won the putting contest. Jon Graham won the award for closest to the pin for men, and Lisa Jones won closest to the pin for women.

Plans are already in the works for the 2012 Tailgate Golf Tournament, and we look forward to seeing you there! ■

Growth and Gratitude

As hard as it is to believe, after only three years of operations, SECU Family House is beginning its planning for an expansion of up to 40 additional bedrooms. The board of directors has established an Expansion Planning Committee, chaired by Mary Beck. Mary has served UNC Hospitals for years as a facilities planner and is an expert at taking projects from vision to fulfillment. She is joined on that committee by Tony Meyer, chief of surgery at UNC Hospitals; Bob Woodruff, president of The Cedars at Meadowmont; and Jim Copeland, our president and former head of UNC Medical Foundation. Luis Morales, our director of operations, Janice Ross, house manager, and I will provide staff support and input. The committee has put out a request for proposals to three architectural firms and will begin interviewing in June. So, exciting times.

The down side is that we are no longer able to fully meet the need for short- and long-term housing for UNC's seriously ill patients and their family caregivers by ourselves. Indeed, for quite some time, our services (housing, transportation, food—and the less quantifiable factors of staying at the House: safety, emotional and psychological well being, camaraderie) have been augmented by our many indispensable partners in the hotel industry. So, I want to give a long overdue “shout-out” to all the local hotels who very willingly care for the guests we are not able to accommodate on a weekly basis. These friends do a wonderful job of greeting and caring for many of our



families who are at wit's end, and offer them room at the inn for significantly reduced rates, ranging from \$39 to \$59:

Guest Sketches

Patricia Sanders stayed at SECU Family House much of the first quarter of 2011 while her 28-year-old daughter, Crystal Sharpe, was waiting for a heart transplant and a kidney transplant—which she received March 27 at UNC Hospitals. Crystal was hospitalized for 100 days, and when Patricia wasn't at her side or making quick trips home to Wilson (Wilson County), NC, to take care of other family, she was at the House. "Everything about Family House is good," Patricia said. "I met a lot of different people there, and we were able to comfort each other. Everybody was nice, and I really liked the different organizations from the community that came to cook."

Geneane Marshall believes "if I could measure my endorphins when I pulled in the SECU Family House driveway, they would be off the chart." Marshall a Roseboro (Sampson County), NC, native and a nurse at the VA Hospital in Fayetteville, stayed at Family House weekdays for five and a half weeks of radiation to treat a tumor in her

head. She cooked with fellow residents and learned to make eggplant parmesan. She also folded laundry with volunteers on Tuesday afternoons. "That was my therapy," Geneane said. She also reconnected with a fellow high school classmate who was staying at Family House while her husband was being treated at UNC Hospitals.

Jean Rogers of Fairmont (Robeson County), NC, spent weekdays at SECU Family House in April and May, undergoing chemotherapy and radiation after having a cancerous parotid gland removed. This career Social Security Administration employee met two other patients at Family House who had also had their parotid glands removed. "A lot of friendship and fellowship goes on here," Jean said. "It's like being in a family home, but also having space to yourself." She breezed through her treatment with no debilitating side effects. "If I wasn't having treatment, I would have thought I was on a vacation. It's that nice," she said.

William Lee Barnes, Jr., has been staying at SECU Family House on-and-off since September of 2010. Diagnosed with pancreatic cancer last fall, the soft-spoken, former textile worker and educator from Garysburg (Northampton County), NC,



exudes a gratitude that is distinctly at odds with the gravity of his disease. At Family House, he tells us, the "atmosphere is like living in heaven. I've never been in a place where people show so much love and compassion." He appreciates that the guests freely discuss their health problems because this lets him know that he's not alone. His attitude is infectious, and we trust that it will serve him well in the months ahead.

Johnny and Phyllis Deal of Lenoir (Caldwell County), NC, stayed at Family House while he was being treated for an uncommon tumor of the thymus gland and two co-existing conditions. "We all have something in common at Family House, and it doesn't take long to find someone who is in far worse shape than you are," Johnny said. "We really are like family here." When Johnny was an inpatient at UNC Hospitals, Phyllis found Family House her needed respite. "I feel safe here, and it's affordable," said Phyllis, a medical secretary. "The volunteers and staff make guests feel like somebody." ■

She was diagnosed in early January 2010 with brain cancer, but had continued to serve as our marketing and volunteer coordinator until very recently, contributing with her usual flair. She was not only a workmate but a cherished friend.

On Wednesday, April 20, at The Chapel of the Cross in Chapel Hill, N.C., a large group of family and friends celebrated her life. Janet was a dedicated and loving mother to her son, Philip, and to her daughter, Tyler, both of whom survive her. The staff here knew her as an

extraordinarily compassionate woman, full of life, light, humor, athleticism, kindness, and warmth. Even at the end, her needs took a back seat to the needs of the rest of the staff, the volunteers she cherished, her children, and her friends. Janet was the calm at the center of many storms.

In her memory—and with donations already made in her memory—we have established the Janet Hudgens Memorial Family Fund, a fund that will defray housing expenses for families who are unable to pay our \$35 a night charge. In keeping with Philip's and Tyler's wishes, we will be pleased to accept any and all donations made in Janet's name and add them to the Fund for this purpose.
